In 2009 we started a Collection Moves programme of low to nil use items to a new storage facility at our Boston Spa site, in West Yorkshire. It is the largest programme of moves we have undertaken since the opening of St Pancras in 1998 and it is intended to secure the condition of these items for the long term.

Latest news on Collection Moves

The move of items to the new Additional Storage Building in Boston Spa is progressing on time, and the transfer of all the assigned material from non-St Pancras sites in London is due to be completed and subsequently accessible to Readers during February 2011. Material will be delivered to Reading Rooms in St Pancras within 48 hours.

The first selection of material to be moved in the second phase of collection moves from St Pancras to the Additional Storage Building (ASB) will consist of the following items:
